In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB098, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act providing that the printing of the Montana Code Annotated is subject to the resident bidder preference for public contract; amending Section 18-7-107, MCA; and providing a retroactive effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The specifications for printing the code will allow for printing on either 35# paper as is currently the case or 50# paper. The lower bidder would be accepted subject to the preference established by this bill.
- 2. Bids received this year will be comparable to bids received in previous years such that the three percent preference may allow acceptance of bids of approximately \$9,000 to \$13,000 greater.
- 3. Higher costs, if experienced, will be passed through to code purchasers. Cost will be allocated to 3200 sets of the code, so added costs could range as high as \$2.81 to \$4.63 per set.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Depending on the low bid and the applicability of the preference Montana Code Annotated purchasers including state and local government agencies could experience added costs of \$2.81 to \$4.63 per set of the codes purchased.
