4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AUDITS  
 5 OF THE MONTANA MEDICAL LEGAL PANEL BY OR AT THE DIRECTION OF  
 6 THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."  
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8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Panel audits. (1) The panel must be  
 10 audited by or at the direction of the legislative auditor in  
 11 accordance with the powers and duties set forth in 5-13-304  
 12 and 5-13-309. The audit must include a determination of the  
 13 adequacy, sufficiency, and reasonableness of the annual  
 14 surcharge or assessment provided for in 27-6-206.

15 (2) A copy of each audit report of the panel must be  
 16 furnished to the supreme court.

17 (3) The cost of any audit of the panel performed  
 18 pursuant to this section must be paid by the panel.

19 Section 2. Implementation schedule. The first audit to  
 20 be conducted under [section 1] must be for the 2 fiscal  
 21 years ending June 30, 1987.

22 Section 3. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
 23 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 27,  
 24 chapter 6, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 6, apply  
 25 to section 1.


