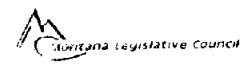

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB130, as amended.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

SB130 is an act allowing parimutuel betting at Montana tracks on simulcast or televised horseraces of national interest.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Assume that affected race tracks handle \$100,000 currently.
2. Assume that 5 tracks will be affected.
3. Assume parimutuel betting on simulcasts will add 25% to applicable track's handle.
4. Assume 70% of track total bets is exotic wagering.
5. Assume boards income is equivalent to 1% of the total handle plus 30% of the 2% of the exotic wagering. (Please note the above board income percentages are set in Section 23-4-202 and 23-4-304, MCA.)
6. Assume the board deficit in income will be offset by cash balance in the treasury.

"23-4-301. Parimutuel betting -- other betting illegal. (1) It is unlawful to make, report, record, or register a bet or wager on the result of a contest of speed, skill, or endurance of an animal, whether the contest is held within or outside of this state, except under this chapter.

(2) A licensee conducting a race meet under this chapter may provide a place in the race meet grounds or enclosure where the licensee may conduct or supervise the use of the parimutuel system by patrons on the result of the races conducted under this chapter and the rules of the board.

(3) A person licensed under this chapter to hold a race meet may, on the day a race meet is conducted, also provide a place in the race meet grounds or enclosure where the licensee may conduct or supervise the use of the parimutuel system by patrons on the results of the following simulcast or televised races:

(a) the Kentucky derby;

(b) the preakness;

(c) the belmont;

(d) the travers; AND

(e) the all-American futurity; and.


