8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 20-5-307, MCA, is amended to read:

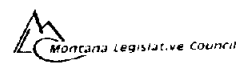
10 "20-5-307. Budgeting, levy requirement, and paying
11 elementary tuition. (1) The tuition amount that has been
12 established in 20-5-305 shall be paid during the ensuing
13 school fiscal year. The trustees of the elementary district
14 shall include such amount in the tuition fund of the
15 preliminary budget. If the trustees should fail to include
16 such amount or any portion of it in the preliminary budget,
17 they shall adjust the budgeted amount in adopting the final
18 budget to provide for the total tuition amount that is due
19 during the ensuing school fiscal year. Such adjustment shall
20 not be subject to the budget adjustment provisions of
21 20-9-132.

22 (2) The county superintendent shall report the net
23 tuition fund levy requirement for each elementary district
24 to the county commissioners on the second Monday of August,
25 and a levy on the district shall be made by the county

1 commissioners in accordance with 20-9-142. Such levy
2 requirement shall be calculated by subtracting from the
3 total expenditure amount authorized in the final tuition
4 fund budget the sum of the cash balance in the tuition fund
5 at the end of the immediately preceding school fiscal year
6 plus any other anticipated moneys that may be realized in
7 the tuition fund.

8 (3) The trustees shall pay by warrants drawn on the
9 tuition fund the tuition amounts owed to each district
10 included in the county superintendent's notification
11 provided under the provisions of 20-5-305. ~~Such payments~~
12 ~~shall be made whenever there is a sufficient amount of cash~~
13 ~~available in the tuition fund but no later than the end of~~
14 ~~the school fiscal year for which the budget was adopted. At~~
15 least one-half of the payments must be made in December, and
16 the remaining payments must be made by June 15 of the fiscal
17 year."

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING PAYMENT OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TUITION IN DECEMBER AND JUNE OF THE FISCAL YEAR; AND AMENDING SECTION 20-5-307, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-5-307, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-5-307. Budgeting, levy requirement, and paying elementary tuition. (1) The tuition amount that has been established in 20-5-305 shall be paid during the ensuing school fiscal year. The trustees of the elementary district shall include such amount in the tuition fund of the preliminary budget. If the trustees should fail to include such amount or any portion of it in the preliminary budget, they shall adjust the budgeted amount in adopting the final budget to provide for the total tuition amount that is due during the ensuing school fiscal year. Such adjustment shall not be subject to the budget adjustment provisions of 20-9-132.

(2) The county superintendent shall report the net tuition fund levy requirement for each elementary district to the county commissioners on the second Monday of August, and a levy on the district shall be made by the county

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commissioners in accordance with 20-9-142. Such levy requirement shall be calculated by subtracting from the total expenditure amount authorized in the final tuition fund budget the sum of the cash balance in the tuition fund at the end of the immediately preceding school fiscal year plus any other anticipated moneys that may be realized in the tuition fund.

(3) The trustees shall pay by warrants drawn on the tuition fund the tuition amounts owed to each district included in the county superintendent's notification provided under the provisions of 20-5-305. ~~Such payments shall be made whenever there is a sufficient amount of cash available in the tuition fund but no later than the end of the school fiscal year for which the budget was adopted. At least one-half of the payments must be made in December, and the remaining payments must be made by June 15 of the fiscal year.~~
