## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to make the crime of conveying a dangerous drug to a person subject to official detention a felony punishable by a prison term not to exceed 10 years and amending section 45-7-307, MCA.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There would be limited population impact on the prison.
- 2. Arrest of civilians for the prescribed activity would number approximately three per year.
- 3. If the proposed statute also is applied to inmates who deal in contraband, some undetermined increase in length of stay of the prison population may result.
