(1) The policy remains in effect until canceled, 16 17 and cancellation may take effect only by written notice to the-named-insured-and-to-the-division at least 20 days prior 18 19 to the date of cancellation: (a) by the insurer to the named insured and the 20 21 division; or 22 (b) by the named insured to the insurer and the 23 division. 24 (2) However, the policy terminates on the effective

25 date of a replacement or succeeding workers' compensation



insurance policy issued to the insured. Nothing in this
section prevents an insurer from canceling a policy of
workers' compensation insurance before a replacement policy
is issued to the insured."

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Extension of authority. Any 6 existing authority of the division of workers' compensation 7 to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act 8 is extended to the provisions of this act.
