4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT BILLS  
 5 AND RESOLUTIONS ON SUBJECTS SPECIFIED IN THE CALL FOR A  
 6 SPECIAL SESSION BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE LEGISLATURE AND THE  
 7 PUBLIC AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE THE SPECIAL SESSION."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Bills to be available seven days prior to  
 11 special session. When the legislature is not in session, all  
 12 bills and resolutions on subjects specified in either the  
 13 governor's call for a special session or the legislature's  
 14 call for a special session must be available for review by  
 15 members of the legislature and the public at least 7 days  
 16 prior to the convening date of the special session.

17 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
 18 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 5,  
 19 chapter 3, part 1, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 3,  
 20 part 1, apply to section 1.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS ~~ON--SUBJECTS--SPECIFIED~~ SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE A CALL FOR A SPECIAL SESSION BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE LEGISLATURE AND THE PUBLIC AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE THE SPECIAL SESSION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Bills to be available seven days prior to special session. When the legislature is not in session, ~~all bills--and--resolutions--on-subjects-specified-in-either-the governor's--call~~ A DRAFT OF ALL BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNOR AFTER HIS CALL for a special session ~~or-the-legislature's-call-for-a-special-session~~ must be available for review by members of the legislature and the public at least 7 days prior to the convening date of the special session.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 5, chapter 3, part 1, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 3, part 1, apply to section 1.
