A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REPEALING SECTIONS 2-18-208 AND 2-18-209, MCA, THAT REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO WORK TOWARD THE GOAL OF ESTABLISHING A STANDARD OF EQUAL PAY FOR COMPARABLE WORTH AND TO REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE THE STATUS OF THE STANDARD UNDER THE STATE CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND PAY SCHEDULES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Repealer. Sections 2-18-208 and 2-18-209, MCA, are repealed.
Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of administration to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
