5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A RESIDENT TO  
6 PURCHASE HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR FAMILY MEMBERS;  
7 AMENDING SECTION 87-2-106, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE  
8 EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 87-2-106, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "87-2-106. Application for license. (1) A license may  
13 be procured from the director, any warden, or any authorized  
14 agent of the director. The applicant shall state his name,  
15 age, occupation, place of residence, post-office address,  
16 the length of time in the state of Montana, whether a  
17 citizen of the United States or an alien, and such other  
18 facts, data, or descriptions as may be required by the  
19 department. Except as provided in subsections (2) ~~and~~ ~~(3)~~  
20 through (4), the statements made by the applicant shall be  
21 subscribed to before the officer or agent issuing the  
22 license.

23 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), department  
24 employees or officers may issue licenses by mail.  
25 Statements on an application for a license to be issued by

1 mail need not be subscribed to before the employee or  
2 officer.

3 (3) To apply for a license under the provisions of  
4 87-2-102(4), the applicant must apply to the director and  
5 must submit at the time of application a notarized affidavit  
6 that attests to fulfillment of the requirements of  
7 87-2-102(4). The director shall process the application in  
8 an expedient manner.

9 (4) A resident may apply for and purchase a wildlife  
10 conservation license, hunting license, and fishing license  
11 for his spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister who is  
12 otherwise qualified to obtain such licenses.

13 ~~(4)~~(5) A license is void unless subscribed to by the  
14 licensee and by an employee or officer of the department or  
15 by a license agent or an authorized representative of the  
16 license agent.

17 ~~(5)~~(6) It is unlawful to subscribe to any statement,  
18 on any application or license, that is materially false.  
19 Any material false statement contained in an application  
20 renders the license issued pursuant to it void. Any person  
21 violating any provision of this statute is guilty of a  
22 misdemeanor."

23 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any  
24 existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and  
25 parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this

1 act is extended to the provisions of this act.
