BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-5-121, MCA, is amended to read:

"87-5-121. Nongame wildlife account. (1) There is a nongame wildlife account in the state special revenue fund provided for in 17-2-102.

- (2) All money collected under 15-30-150 and all interest earned by the fund before being expended under this section must be deposited in the account, -except-as-provided in-subsection-(6).
- (3) Money in the account must be used by the department, upon the approval of the commission as determined under 87-5-122, to provide adequate funding for:
- 23 (a) research and education programs on nongame 24 wildlife in Montana, as provided for in 87-5-104; and
  - (b) any management programs for nongame wildlife

approved by the legislature under 87-5-105 as species or subspecies in need of management.

- (4) The money is available to the department in the same manner as provided in 87-1-601, except that no money collected under 15-30-150 may be used:
- (a) for the purchase of any real property; or
- (b) in such a way as to interfere with the productionon or management of private property.

# STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

### Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB177, as introduced.

# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill continues the non-game wildlife checkoff program; removes the prohibition of spending license dollars in the non-game wildlife program; and repeals the authority of the Department of Revenue to deduct administrative costs from the checkoff revenue.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. This bill does not change the existing non-game wildlife tax checkoff program.
- 2. This bill repeals the prohibition of spending license dollars on the non-game wildlife program.
- 3. This bill repeals the authority of the Department of Revenue to deduct administrative costs from the checkoff revenue. The Department of Revenue requested \$8,200 per year for the 1988-89 biennium to administer the non-game checkoff program.
- 4. An additional appropriation would be needed by the Department of Revenue to compensate for expenses incurred administering the program.
