A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING SUSPENSION OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR IN COURT OR FAILURE TO PAY A FINE, COSTS, OR RESTITUTION AFTER CONVICTION OF CERTAIN OFFENSES."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Mandatory suspension for failure to appear or pay fine. The department shall suspend the license or driving privilege of an operator or chauffeur immediately upon receipt of a certified copy of a docket page or other sufficient evidence from the court that the operator or chauffeur:

- (1) is guilty of a violation of 61-5-302 through 61-5-306, 61-5-309, or chapters 3, 7, 8, 9, or 10 of this title or is guilty of a criminal offense and was driving or was in actual physical control of a motor vehicle when the offense occurred; and
- 21 (2) (a) failed to appear as ordered by the court or 22 upon issued summons; or
- 23 (b) failed to pay a fine, costs, or restitution 24 amount; and
- 25 (3) received notice, evidenced by a signed receipt for

a certified letter or by a statement signed before the court of the provisions of this section.

Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing
authority of the department of justice to make rules on the
subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
provisions of this act.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act requiring suspension of a driver's license for failure to appear in court or failure to pay a fine, costs or restitution after conviction of certain offenses.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. 120,000 convictions annually for the violations listed in the bill.
- 2. 25% of the convictions currently do not appear or fail to pay, but due to the leverage provided by this bill, half of the 25% will now appear and/or pay. And, of the remaining half, 50% would eventually appear and/or pay after their license was suspended.
- 3. The average fine is \$35 that includes a \$7.50 court cost and a \$10 surcharge to fund deputy county attorneys.
- 4. The total conviction ratio between state and local is the same as the DUI ratio; that is state 25%, local 75%.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act requiring suspension of a driver's license for failure to appear in court or failure to pay a fine, costs or restitution after conviction of certain offenses; and requiring payment of a reinstatement fee.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. 18,000 convictions annually with a fine of over \$100 for the violations listed in the bill.
- 2. 50% of the current convictions will not pay. But 30% of the "50% will not pays" will pay upon the threat of losing their licenses. Half of the remaining 70% of the "50% will not pays", will eventually pay after their licenses have been suspended.
- 3. The average fine over \$100 is \$125, which includes a \$7.50 court cost, and a \$10 fee for deputy county attorneys.
