21 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-3-127, MCA, is amended to read:

"87-3-127. Taking of stock-killing or apiary-damaging
animals. (1) Livestock owners or employees of the department
or the federal fish and wildlife service may use dogs in
pursuit of stock-killing bears, stock-killing mountain
lions, and stock-killing bobcats. Other means of taking
stock-killing bears, stock-killing mountain lions, and
stock-killing bobcats may be used, except the use of the
deadfall.

(2) In this section stock-killing, with reference to bears, includes damage to bees and apiaries.

23 (2)(3) Traps used in capturing bears shall be 24 inspected twice each day with the inspections 12 hours 25 apart.

Section 87-3-130, MCA, is amended to read: 5 6 "87-3-130. Taking of wildlife to protect persons, 7 apiaries, or livestock. (1) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to impose, by implication or otherwise, criminal liability for the taking of wildlife protected by this chapter if such wildlife is molesting, assaulting, killing, or threatening to kill any person, apiary, or livestock. Any person who so takes any wildlife protected by this chapter shall notify the department within 72 hours.

(4) Subsection (1) does not apply to owners of bees

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to owners of bees and apiaries or agents of the owners unless the apiaries are protected by electric fencing constructed according to specifications provided by the department."

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
