(1) Except as otherwise provided herein, no person 14 shall operate a motor vehicle upon the public highways of 15 this state unless such vehicle is properly registered and 16 has the proper number plates conspicuously displayed, one on 17 the front and one on the rear of the vehicle, each securely 18 fastened to prevent it from swinging and unobstructed from 19 plain view, except that trailers. semitrailers.

3 (3) (a) The proceeds from the sale of commemorative 4 license plates, after payment of the agreed price to the 5 department, must be used for centennial activities of the 6 office as provided in part 1 of this chapter.

7 (b) The issuance of commemorative license plates must8 be made at no direct cost to the state.

9 (4) Commemorative license plates that are valid for 10 licensing a motor vehicle must carry the assigned county 11 number letters, as established in 61-3-332(8), either within 12 the registration numbers or by means of an affixed nonremovable sticker bearing the appropriate county 13 designation and used in accordance with instructions by the 14 15 department. (Terminates July 1, 1991--sec. 5, Ch. 674, L. 1985.)" 16

18 applies to motor vehicle license plates issued on or after
19 January 1, 1988.
