A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT ALLOWING, EACH LEGISLATOR, TO REQUEST NO MORE THAN SEVEN BILLS PRIOR TO OR DURING A LEGISLATIVE SESSION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA,

Section 1. Bill limit. (1) A legislator may request no more than seven bills prior to or during a regular or

special session of the legislature. This limit does not apply to:

- (a) interim committee bills;
 - (b) standing committee bills;
 - (c) revenue bills; or
 - (d) code commissioner bills.
- (2) Any legislator may transfer his authority to request a bill to another legislator.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 5, chapter 4, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 4, apply to section 1.
