4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO RESERVE UP TO 10
5 PERCENT OF THE AUTHORIZED CLASS A-7 ANTLERLESS ELK LICENSES
6 FOR NONAMBULATORY DISABLED PERSONS; AND AMENDING SECTION
7 87-2-506, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 87-2-506, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "87-2-506. Restrictions on hunting licenses. (1) The
12 department may prescribe by rule the number of hunting
13 licenses to be issued. Any license sold may be restricted to
14 a specific administrative region, hunting district, or other
15 designated area and may specify the species, age, and sex to
16 be taken and the time period for which the license is valid.

17 (2) When the number of valid resident applications for
18 big game licenses or permits of a single class or type
19 exceeds the number of licenses or permits the department
20 desires to issue in an administrative region, hunting
21 district, or other designated area, then the number of big
22 game licenses or permits issued to nonresident license or
23 permit holders in the region, district, or area may not
24 exceed 10% of the total issued.

25 (3) The department shall reserve up to 10% of the

1 number of Class A-7 licenses authorized by the commission in
2 an administrative region, hunting district, or other
3 designated area for applicants who are certified as
4 nonambulatory and disabled as prescribed by department
5 rule."

6 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
7 existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and
8 parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this
9 act is extended to the provisions of this act.

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB352, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill would reserve up to 10% of the authorized Class A-7 antlerless elk licenses for nonambulatory disabled persons.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Disabled would be required to purchase a disabled conservation license to apply for the drawings.
2. There would be 5 A-7 districts statewide, rather than the current 1.
3. The Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks estimates that 200 nonambulatory disabled sportsmen will apply.
4. The bill will require computer programming, testing and edits in the first year of implementation.

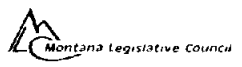
