### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill would reserve up to 10% of the authorized Class A-7 antlerless elk licenses for nonambulatory disabled persons.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

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1. Disabled would be required to purchase a disabled conservation license to apply for the drawings.

2. There would be 5 A-7 districts statewide, rather than the current 1.

3. The Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks estimates that 200 nonambulatory disabled sportsmen will apply.

4. The bill will require computer programming, testing and edits in the first year of implementation.
