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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 32-1-204, MCA, is amended to read:

"32-1-204. Hearings -- notice. (1) A hearing shall be

13 conducted upon all applications for new bank certificates of

14 authorization, in accordance with the Montana Administrative

15 Procedure Act relating to a contested case, whether or not

any protest to the application is filed.

- (2) A notice of the filing of an application for a new bank certificate of authorization shall be mailed to all banks within 100 miles of the proposed location, measured in a straight line.
- 21 (3) A hearing shall be conducted no sooner than 30 22 days and not later than 90 days following the mailing of 23 such notice.
- 24 (4) Any bank filing a written protest with the board 25 prior to the date of the hearing shall be admitted as a



- "party", as defined in the Montana Administrative Procedure
 Act, with full rights of a party, including the right of
 subpoena of witnesses and written materials, the right of
 cross-examination, the right to have a transcript, and the
 right to receive all notices, copy of the application, all
 orders, and the right of judicial review and appeal.
- 7 (5) All applications for mergers, consolidations, or 8 relocations of banks shall likewise require a hearing, and 9 all of the rights and procedures stated herein shall apply 10 to these matters.
- (6) Notwithstanding the requirements of subsections
 (1) through (5), when the deposit liability of any closed
 bank is to be transferred to or assumed by a state bank
 being organized for that purpose, the board is empowered to
 issue a certificate of authorization without notice or
 hearing, according to rules adopted by the board."
