4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
5	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THAT THE
6	PRISONER OF WAR FLAG BE FLOWN OVER THE STATE CAPITOL;
7	SENDING A STRONG SIGNAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED
8	STATES AND THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS THAT IT IS THE DESIRE
9	OF THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MONTANA THAT ALL MEANS
.0	AVAILABLE SHALL BE USED TO EFFECT THE RELEASE OF ALL
.1	PRISONERS OF WAR AND TO ACCOUNT FOR ALL SERVICEMEN MISSING
. 2	IN ACTION.
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4	WHEREAS, 13 long years after American involvement in
L5	the Vietnam War ended, 2,400 American servicemen, including
16	17 Montanans, still remain unaccounted for; and
L7	WHEREAS, the American people believe that the
18	Indo-Chinese governments are still holding American
L 9	prisoners of war (POW); and
20	WHEREAS, numerous sightings of alleged American
21	prisoners of war have been reported to the Defense
22	Intelligence Agency since the mid-1970s; and
23	WHEREAS, almost 600 American servicemen are missing in
2 4	action (MIA) in Laos, and Laos has returned no American
25	servicemen; and

1	WHEREAS, one of the highest priorities of President
2	Ronald Reagan is to resolve the POW/MIA issue.
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4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
5	OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
6	That the Montana Legislature hereby direct that the POW
7	flag be flown over the Montana State Capitol until an
8	accounting of all POWs and MIAs has been concluded, in order
9	to demonstrate the commitment that the citizens of the State
10	of Montana have to our brave men who fought for our country.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montana Legislature
12	perform this action in order to send a strong signal to
13	President Reagan and the United States Congress that it is
14	the desire of the people of the State of Montana that all
15	means available be used to effect the earliest possible
16	release of all POWs and as full an accounting of all MIAs as
17	possible.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State
19	distribute copies of this resolution to the President of the
20	United States, the President of the United States Senate,
21	the Charles of the United States House of Benrasantatives
