4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
 5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE BOARD OF
 6 REGENTS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO MAINTAIN AND EXPAND THE
 7 GRANTING OF FEE WAIVERS FOR FACULTY AND STAFF OF THE
 8 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.

 10 WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of Higher Education has a
 11 formal policy to grant fee waivers, except registration and
 12 building fees, to the Montana University System faculty and
 13 staff who are at least three-fourths time salaried
 14 employees; and

15 WHEREAS, this policy and benefit encourages the
 16 attraction and retention of well-qualified employees for the
 17 University System, especially at a time when there are
 18 limitations on other monetary benefits for such employees;
 19 and

20 WHEREAS, this policy and benefit could be expanded to
 21 attract and retain well-qualified professors and associate
 22 professors by offering the fee waiver policy to the spouses
 23 and children of such University System employees.

 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE

1 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 2 That the Board of Regents of Higher Education be urged
 3 to continue the policy of offering fee waivers to University
 4 System faculty and staff.
 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Regents be urged to
 6 expand the fee waiver policy to include fee waivers for the
 7 spouses and children of full-time professors and associate
 8 professors.
