FISCAL IMPACT:

The Department will comply with the intent of the resolution and begin to institute an electronic filing program. In order to limit Department expenditures for computer hardware and software, the Department would develop standard specifications for electronic filing. These specifications would address filing formats, the return information, and equipment/software compatibility requirements.

When implemented, the program would result in a seasonal cost savings to the Department for data entry. The amount of savings would depend on the popularity of the program.
