4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TWO
5 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BE CHOSEN FROM THE STATE AT LARGE AND
6 ONE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR BE CHOSEN FROM EACH CONGRESSIONAL
7 DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR VOTING BY ELECTORS BASED ON AREA OF
8 REPRESENTATION; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 13-25-101, 13-25-102,
9 AND 13-25-104, MCA."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 **Section 1.** Section 13-25-101, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "13-25-101. Nomination of electors -- ballot. (1) Each
14 political party qualified under 13-10-601 shall nominate one
15 presidential elector from each congressional district and
16 two electors at large for this state and file certificates
17 of nomination for these candidates with the secretary of
18 state no later than 75 days before the general election, in
19 the manner and number provided by law.

20 (2) The secretary of state shall certify to the
21 election administrator the names of the candidates for
22 president and vice president of the several political
23 parties, which shall be printed on the ballot.

24 (3) The names of candidates for electors of president
25 and vice president may not be printed upon the ballot."

1 **Section 2.** Section 13-25-102, MCA, is amended to read:

2 "13-25-102. Election of electors. (1) On the Tuesday
3 next after the first Monday of November in the year in which
4 a president of the United States is to be elected, there
5 shall be elected as many electors for president and vice
6 president of the United States as are allocated to this
7 state.

8 (2) The votes cast for candidates for president and
9 vice president of each political party in each congressional
10 district and for the state at large shall be counted for the
11 candidates for presidential electors of the political party
12 whose names have been filed with the secretary of state."

13 **Section 3.** Section 13-25-104, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "13-25-104. Meeting and voting of electors. (1) The
15 electors shall meet in Helena at 2 p.m. on the first Monday
16 after the second Wednesday in December following their
17 election.

18 (2) The electors shall vote by separate ballots for
19 one person for president and one for vice president of the
20 United States.

21 ~~(3) The electors shall cast their ballots for the~~
22 ~~persons who received the highest number of votes~~ Votes for
23 president and vice president of the United States,
24 respectively, must be cast, according to the number of votes
25 in the most recently conducted general election in the state

1 of Montana:

2 (a) by the electors at large for the persons who
3 received the highest number of votes in the state; and

4 (b) by the elector from each congressional district
5 for the persons who received the largest number of votes in
6 that congressional district."
