HOUSE BILL NO. 42

INTRODUCED BY STANG

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A TOWN OR CITY TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT MINORS FROM ENTERING LICENSED RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS THAT SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES; AND PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE MAY ALLOW ENTRANCE TO CERTAIN AREAS OF SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS THAT OPERATE ANOTHER BUSINESS OR CONDUCT AN EVENT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Prohibiting minors by ordinance from entering licensed retail establishments. An incorporated town or city may enact an ordinance prohibiting minors from entering licensed establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold to the public for consumption on the premises of the retailer. The ordinance may prohibit entrance to areas within an establishment where the alcoholic beverages are sold but allow entrance to areas where another business is operated, such as a restaurant, hotel, or store, or where an event is conducted, such as a sporting event or fair.

**Section 2.** Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 16, and the provisions of Title 16 apply to [section 1].
