In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB111, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This prepared Legislation would amend Section 61-3-508 MCA to increase the Junk Vehicle License Registration Fee from \$.50 to \$1.10.

ASSUMPTIONS:

Assumed - Vehicle registration will increase 1.16% per year; title transfers will increase .71% per year; license fees \$11,100; crushing revenues \$50,000 per year. Assumed the State Solid Waste program and 50% of the Environmental Sciences Division Administrator's budget will be funded by this budget. Figures include fiscal year fund balance carryover.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

Slight increase in grants to local governments is expected for this biennium. If the legislation is not passed, local grants may be decreased accordingly to balance the program's budget.

LONG RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

If this legislation is passed the Junk Vehicle program should remain solvent. If this legislation is not passed, program cuts will have to be made accordingly. These effects would be felt on the state and local program levels in reduced numbers of junk vehicles collected and recycled.

An additional 17 special junk vehicle disposal fee shall be assessed in the 18 amount of 50-cents \$1-10 75 CENTS on each passenger car and 19 truck under 8,001 pounds GVW registered for licensing.
