# -2- INTRODUCED BILL HB 120

#### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB120, as introduced.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

HB120 establishes the nonresident fur dealer's license fee at the rate set for a similar license in the nonresident's state of residence or at \$10 if no rate is set there.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The average number of nonresident fur dealer licenses issued by the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks for the past four years is 16 licenses and this number will continue.
- 2. The state of residence for FY88 fur dealer licenses issued to nonresidents is representative and will continue to be representative.
- 3. The very competitive nature of the fur-buying industry will create resistance from nonresidents whose states have fees significantly higher than Montana's current fee of \$50, e.g., North Dakota (\$500) and South Dakota (\$400).
