STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB120, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

HB120 establishes the nonresident fur dealer's license fee at the rate set for a similar license in the nonresident's state of residence or at \$10 if no rate is set there.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The average number of nonresident fur dealer licenses issued by the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks for the past four years is 16 licenses and this number will continue.
2. The state of residence for FY88 fur dealer licenses issued to nonresidents is representative and will continue to be representative.
3. The very competitive nature of the fur-buying industry will create resistance from nonresidents whose states have fees significantly higher than Montana's current fee of \$50, e.g., North Dakota (\$500) and South Dakota (\$400).


