5 PRIZE ON CERTAIN BINGO GAMES; AND AMENDING SECTION 23-5-412,

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9 **Section 1.** Section 23-5-412, MCA, is amended to read:
10 "23-5-412. Bingo prizes. Bingo prizes may be paid in
11 either tangible personal property or cash, except that a
12 prize must be paid in tangible personal property if the game
13 is played on a player-operated electronic video game
14 machine. A prize may not exceed the value of ~~\$100~~ \$800 for
15 each individual bingo award, except that if the game is
16 played on a player-operated electronic video game machine, a
17 prize may not exceed the value of \$100 for each individual
18 bingo award. The price for an individual bingo card may not
19 exceed 50 cents. It shall be unlawful to, in any manner,
20 combine any awards so as to increase the ultimate value of
21 such award."
