    Section 1. Section 23-5-412, MCA, is amended to read:
    "23-5-412. Bingo prizes. Bingo prizes may be paid in either tangible personal property or cash, except that a prize must be paid in tangible personal property if the game is played on a player-operated electronic video game machine. A prize may not exceed the value of $\$ \neq \theta \theta \underline{\$ 00}$ for each individual bingo award, except that if the game is played on a player-operated electronic video game machine, a prize may not exceed the value of $\$ 100$ for each individual bingo award. The price for an individual bingo card may not exceed 50 cents. It shall be unlawful to, in any manner, combine any awards so as to increase the ultimate value of such award."
