13	"80-7-503. Duties of department. The department shall

16	for control of insect pests;
17	(2) develop and publish technical guidelines on
18	techniques of controlling insect pests;
19	(3) notify a county of its survey results and state
20	whether the infestation is normal or serious;
21	(4) review and comment on or review and approve all
22	county agricultural insect pest management plans as provided
23	by local government statutes and consider whether the plan
24	conforms to the technical guidelines of the department and

whether implementation of the plan will probably counteract

2	proper manner;
3	(5) consider whether an alternative control program
4	would be as efficient as spraying on a ratio of total costs
5	to total benefits and provide the county with a summary of
6	its findings prior to conducting or approving any cropland
7	spraying program. If the alternative control program is
8	considered adequate, the department may conduct or approve
9	such a program."

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
