Section 1. Section 7-14-4114, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-14-4114. Procedure to discontinue streets. (1) The

council may discontinue a street or alley or any part thereof in a city or town upon-the-petition-in-writing-of all-owners-of-lots-on-the-street-or-alley, if it can be done

without detriment to the public interest, upon:

17 <u>(a) a petition in writing of all owners of lots on the</u>
18 <u>street or alley; or</u>

(b) (i) a petition in writing of more than 50% of the owners of lots on the street or alley; and

- (ii) approval by a majority vote of the council.
- (2) Where the street or alley is to be closed for school purposes, the council may discontinue the street or alley upon a petition signed by 75% of the lot owners on the whole street or alley to be closed will-be-required.
