BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 37-32-310, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "37-32-310. Refusal, revocation, or suspension of
13 licenses -- grounds -- notice and hearing. (1) The board may
14 deny, refuse to renew, revoke, suspend, impose a fine not to
15 exceed \$500 an incident, or take other disciplinary action

against a licensee in any of the following cases:

- 17 (a) failure of a person, firm, partnership, or 18 corporation operating an electrology salon or school of 19 electrology to comply with this chapter or rules adopted 20 under this chapter;
- 21 (b) failure to comply with sanitary rules adopted by 22 the board for the regulation of electrology salons or 23 schools of electrology;
  - (c) gross malpractice or repeated malpractice;
  - (d) continued practice by a person knowingly having an



- 1 infectious or contagious disease;
- 2 (e) habitual drunkenness or addiction to any
  3 habit-forming drug;
- 4 (f) permitting a license to be used when the holder is 5 not personally, actively, and continuously engaged in 6 business;
- 7 (g) unprofessional conduct as defined by rules of the 8 board; or
- 9 (h) failure to display the license.
- 10 (2) Title 2, chapter 4, part 6, applies to all
  11 contested cases under this chapter."
- NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority to make rules on the subject of the provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of [this act].
