In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB216, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Changing the audit period of the Montana Health Facility Authority from an annual audit to a biennial audit; amending Section 90-7-121, MCA; and providing an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The department audit will be completed in FY90 and the program audit in FY91.
2. The Legislative Auditor has indicated a two year audit will require more hours than a one year audit.
3. There will be 1991 biennium ~~savings~~ of \$2,081.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 90-7-121, MCA, is amended to read:

"90-7-121. Annual Biennial audit. The authority's books and records must be audited at least once each fiscal year biennium, by or at the direction of the legislative auditor. The actual costs of the audit shall be paid from the authority's funds."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Extension of authority. Any existing authority to make rules on the subject of the provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of [this act].

NEW SECTION. **Section 3.** Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
