DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The act authorizes the Department of Commerce to establish an annual conference on the state of Montana business; appropriates general fund to be matched by private funds; and provides an effective date of July 1, 1989.

1. The Department of Commerce will be successful in generating private funds to match the \$5,000 general fund appropriation.
