# STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB258, as introduced.

# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

HB258 creates a Board of Passenger Tramway Safety, transferring to the board the powers, duties and functions of the Department of Commerce relating to tramways and limiting liability.

# **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- The board will meet three times per year consistent with the current Tramway Advisory Council; however, the meetings will last two days rather than one day and compensation for the members will increase from \$25 per day for council members to \$50 per day for board members.
- 2. The location of board meetings and the respective costs will be comparable to the current expenditures of the advisory council.
- 3. The tramway rules will be completely redone in FY90.
- 4. Because the tramway program has never been budgeted to pay for Depart ment of Commerce support services and overhead, this adjustment would occur regardless of status as an advisory council or a board.
- 5. The figures used for the current program at the 1991 biennium executive budget recommendations.
