 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE INSTRUCTION
 6 IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS RELATING TO ABSTINENCE BY ADOLESCENTS FROM
 7 ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS, AND SEX OUT OF WEDLOCK; TO PROHIBIT
 8 INSTRUCTION OR SERVICES RELATING TO BIRTH CONTROL OR
 9 ABORTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARENTS'
 10 ADVISORY COUNCILS; AMENDING SECTION 20-7-111, MCA; AND
 11 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 **Section 1.** Section 20-7-111, MCA, is amended to read:
 14 "20-7-111. Instruction in public schools. (1) The
 15 board of public education shall define and specify the basic
 16 instructional program for pupils in public schools, and such
 17 program shall be set forth in the standards of
 18 accreditation.
 19 (2) Each board of trustees shall prescribe
 20 instructional programs concerning abstinence by adolescents
 21 from alcohol, illegal drugs, and sex out of wedlock, which
 22 shall be provided by each public school in the district.
 23 (3) Other instruction may be given when approved by
 24 the board of trustees.
 25 (4) No instructional program may be offered in a

1 public school in this state that includes material relating
 2 to the availability and use of birth control measures or
 3 abortion, and no birth control or abortion services or
 4 referrals may be provided at any public school."

5 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Parents' advisory council on
 6 school programs. A board of trustees may establish a
 7 volunteer advisory council composed of parents of children
 8 attending public schools in the district to advise the
 9 trustees on matters concerning the requirements of
 10 20-7-111(2) and (4).

11 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction.
 12 [Section 2] is intended to be codified as an integral part
 13 of Title 20, chapter 1, part 2, and the provisions of Title
 14 20 apply to [section 2].

15 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is
 16 effective July 1, 1989.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill for an Act entitled: "An Act to require instruction in public schools relating to abstinence by adolescents from alcohol, illegal drugs, and sex out of wedlock; to prohibit instruction or services relating to birth control or abortion; to authorize the establishment of parents' advisory councils; amending Section 20-7-111, MCA; and providing an effective date."

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Program costs for OPI would be comparable to similar programs recently developed at OPI.
2. Teacher training would be required, curriculum developed, and current curriculum studied for deletion.
