6	"EMPLOYER" AS USED IN THE HUMAN RIGHTS STATUTES TO ENSURE		
7	THAT THE DEFINITION INCLUDES PERSONS, FIRMS, CORPORATIONS,		
8	AND INSTITUTIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 49-2-101, MCA."		
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10	WHEREAS, Article II, section 4, of the 1972 Montana		
11	Constitution prohibits discrimination by the state or any		
12	person, firm, corporation, or institution against any person		
13	on account of social condition; and		
14	WHEREAS, the intent of the 1972 Constitutional		
15	Convention should be implemented by defining the term		
16	"employer" to include a broad range of business		
17	relationships, such as agents, contractors, successors, and		
18	assigns; and		
19	WHEREAS, the definition of "employer" should be		
20	clarified to provide that the employment relationship		
21	includes situations where there is control of another who		
22	provides services for compensation or consideration.		
23	THEREFORE, the Legislature finds it appropriate to		

amend the current definition of "employer" in section

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Section 1. Section 49-2-101, MCA, is amended to read: "49-2-101. Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the context requires otherwise, the following definitions apply: (1) "Age" means number of years since birth. It does not mean level of maturity or ability to handle responsibility. These latter criteria may represent legitimate considerations as reasonable grounds discrimination without reference to age. (2) "Commission" means the commission for human rights provided for in 2-15-1706. (3) "Credit" means the right granted by a creditor to a person to defer payment of a debt, to incur debt and defer its payment, or to purchase property or services and defer payment therefor. It includes without limitation the right to incur and defer debt which is secured by residential real property. (4) "Credit transaction" means any invitation to apply for credit, application for credit, extension of credit, or credit sale. 22 (5) "Creditor" means a person who, regularly or as a 23 part of his business, arranges for the extension of credit

for which the payment of a financial charge or interest is

required, whether in connection with loans, sale of property or services, or otherwise.

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- (6) "Educational institution" means a public or private institution and includes an academy; college; elementary or secondary school; extension course; kindergarten; nursery; school system; university; business, nursing, professional, secretarial, technical, or vocational school; or agent of an educational institution.
- 9 (7) "Employee" means any individual employed by an employer.
- 11 (8) "Employer" means an-employer-of-one-or-more persons--but any person, firm, corporation, or institution 12 (including agents, contractors, successors, and assigns), 13 and those under its direction or control, that engages one 14 or more persons in its service for compensation or 15 consideration of any kind. The term does not include a 16 fraternal, charitable, or religious association or 17 18 corporation if the association or corporation is not 19 organized either for private profit or to provide accommodations or services that are available on a 20 21 nonmembership basis.
- 22 (9) "Employment agency" means a person undertaking to 23 procure employees or opportunities to work.
- (10) "Financial institution" means a commercial bank,trust company, savings bank, finance company, savings and

- loan association, investment company, or insurance company.
- 2 (11) "Housing accommodation" means a building or 3 portion of a building, whether constructed or to be 4 constructed, which is or will be used as the sleeping 5 quarters of its occupants.
- 6 (12) "Labor organization" means an organization or an agent of an organization organized for the purpose, in whole 8 or in part, of collective bargaining, of dealing with 9 employers concerning grievances or terms or conditions of 10 employment, or of other mutual aid and protection of 11 employees.
- 12 (13) "Mental handicap" means any mental disability 13 resulting in subaverage intellectual functioning or impaired 14 social competence.
- 15 (14) "National origin" means ancestry.

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- (15) "Person" means one or more individuals, labor unions, partnerships, associations, corporations, legal representatives, mutual companies, joint-stock companies, trusts, unincorporated employees' associations, employers, employment agencies, or labor organizations.
- 21 (16) "Physical handicap" means a physical disability,
 22 infirmity, malformation, or disfigurement which is caused by
 23 bodily injury, birth defect, or illness, including epilepsy.
 24 It includes without limitation any degree of paralysis;
- 25 amputation; lack of physical coordination; blindness or

- visual impediment; deafness or hearing impediment; muteness or speech impediment; or physical reliance on a guide dog for the blind, a wheelchair, or any other remedial appliance or device.
- (17) "Public accommodation" means a place which caters 5 or offers its services, goods, or facilities to the general 7 public subject only to the conditions and limitations established by law and applicable to all persons alike. It 9 includes without limitation a public inn, restaurant, eating 10 house, hotel, roadhouse, place where food or alcoholic 11 beverages or malt liquors are sold for consumption, motel, 12 soda fountain, soft drink parlor, tavern, nightclub, trailer park, resort, campground, barbershop, beauty parlor, 13 14 bathroom, resthouse, theater, swimming pool, skating rink, 15 golf course, cafe, ice cream parlor, transportation company, 16 or hospital and all other public amusement and business 17 establishments.
- 18 (18) "Staff" or "commission staff" means the staff of 19 the commission for human rights."
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2.** Extension of authority. Any 21 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the 22 provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of [this act].

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
