BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 37-8-301, MCA, is amended to read:

"37-8-301. Nursing education programs -- application
for approval -- faculty qualifications. (1) An institution
desiring to conduct a nursing education program in the state
shall apply to the department and submit evidence that it is
prepared to carry out an educational program that complies
with the provisions of this chapter and the rules adopted by
the board pursuant to this section.

- (2) Nursing school faculty members, including part-time and substitute faculty members in all areas of the nursing education program, shall hold as a minimum qualification a master's degree in nursing or a master's degree in a related field which includes advanced nursing courses or graduate level nursing education courses.
- (3) The board shall adopt rules relating to the conduct of nursing education programs that are directed toward insuring qualifications to practice as a professional

nurse or a practical nurse in those areas of service specified in 37-8-102."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority to make rules on the subject of the provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of [this act].
