4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A 5 LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE TO CONSIDER ISSUES RELATED TO THE 6 GOVERNANCE AND FUNDING OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION; PROVIDING 7 AN APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND A 8 TERMINATION DATE."

10 WHEREAS, postsecondary education provides opportunities 11 for the citizens of Montana to develop their educational 12 potential; and

13 WHEREAS, as a result of the work of the University 14 Funding Study Committee during the 1989 biennium, valuable 15 conclusions were reached regarding the reliability and use 16 of peer data and the level of funding for Montana 17 postsecondary education institutions relative to peer 18 institutions; and

19 WHEREAS, the conclusions reached on peer data have 20 removed a major impediment to working cooperatively on 21 elements of the higher education funding formula and have 22 changed the direction for Montana University System 23 budgeting; and

WHEREAS, the relationship between the Montana
University System and the Legislature has been significantly

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1 improved by the work of the University Funding Study
2 Committee; and

3 WHEREAS, further work is needed to more fully develop
4 new budgeting formulas and to complete work on personnel and
5 classroom enrollment systems; and

6 WHEREAS, the balance from the \$150,000 appropriated by
7 the 1987 Legislature to conduct the university funding study
8 may be expended to support the costs of a postsecondary
9 education study committee.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Postsecondary education study 12 13 committee --- establishment -- appointment --staff 14 assistance. (1) There is a postsecondary education study committee comprised of four members of the senate appointed 15 by the committee on committees and four members of the house 16 of representatives appointed by the speaker. Not more than 17 two members from either house may be from the same political 18 party. In case of a vacancy, a replacement must be appointed 19 by the appointing authority who appointed the member whose 20 absence resulted in the vacancy. 21

(2) The study must be coordinated by the office of the
legislative fiscal analyst in conjunction with the
commissioner of higher education and with active
participation of the office of budget and program planning.

INTRODUCED BILL -2-HB 354

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Committee to conduct study.
 The postsecondary education study committee shall, in
 cooperation with the board of regents and the governor,
 examine:

5 (1) the governance and funding of postsecondary6 education;

7 (2) the duplication of functions and programs among8 the postsecondary education institutions;

9 (3) the policy questions surrounding the issues of 10 "priority of access" versus "excellence"; and

11 (4) the development and implementation of uniform 12 personnel and classroom enrollment systems for postsecondary 13 education institutions.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation. The balances 14 remaining as of June 30, 1989, in the appropriations 15 included in House Bill No. 2, Laws of 1987, to the 16 commissioner of higher education, the office of the 17 18 legislative fiscal analyst, and the office of budget and program planning for the university funding study are 19 appropriated to the respective agencies for the biennium 20 ending June 30, 1991, for the purpose of supporting the 21 22 costs of the postsecondary education study committee.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 4. Effective date - termination. [This act] is effective July 1, 1989, and
 terminates June 30, 1991.
