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ACT TO DIRECT THE MONTANA Felle BILL OOR AN ACT ENTITLED: HIGHWAYS TO TRANSFER CERTAIN LANDS TO Brake YELLOWSTONE COUNTY SO THAT YELLOWSTONE COUNTY MAY MAKE THE Hagen AND BOTANICAL Penglan GARDERS: AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE." 9 WHEREAS, the Montana Department of Highways owns a 10 parcel of land near Billings along Interstate 90 near the 11 12 proposed Shiloh interchange for which the department has no 13 need; and 14 WHEREAS, Yellowstone County and a private corporation known as ZooMontana, Inc. have discussed with the department 15 16 the transfer of the land to Yellowstone County, which in turn would make the land available to ZooMontana, Inc. for 17 18 use as a zoo and botanical gardens; and 19 WHEREAS, ZooMontana, Inc. plans high-quality regional zoo and botanical gardens to fulfill 20 21 educational, recreational, and research purposes; and 22 WHEREAS, the zoo and botanical gardens will attract 23 many visitors from the city of Billings, from around the 24 state of Montana, and from out of state; and

WHEREAS, the zoo and botanical gardens will become a

major tourist attraction and is expected to bring over 50,000 people into the zoo each year from out of the region who will spend in excess of one million each year, which will benefit the entire state; and

WHEREAS, funds for the construction of the facility are

WHEREAS, funds for the construction of the facility are being raised locally and regionally, with an expectation that \$4.5 million will be raised; and

WHEREAS, the ZooMontana development promises to be of major benefit to Montana in terms of educational and recreational opportunities while at the same time infusing money into the state's economy.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Disposition of certain highway property to Yellowstone County. (1) The department of highways is directed to transfer its interest, including appurtenant water rights, in the property described in subsection (2) to Yellowstone County. Yellowstone County shall make the land available to ZooMontana, Inc., a corporation, for the development of a zoo, botanical gardens, and related facilities.

- (3) The department is authorized to provide an easement or otherwise grant title to or use of land owned by the department that is contiguous to the land described in subsection (2) for the purpose of providing access to the land described in subsection (2). The additional grant or easement may be made if the department determines that use for access will not interfere with highway department use of the contiguous land.
- (4) The department of highways may establish appropriate conditions to protect the interest of the state on the transfer of the property, including a provision for reversion should the property cease to be used for zoo and botanical garden purposes.
