BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB391, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

"An Act to extend collection of penalties and interest on overdue employer contributions to the state unemployment insurance fund for use by the Department of Labor and Industry to administer the unemployment insurance law and for programs to train and retrain unemployed and underemployed persons; amending Section 3, Chapter 13, special laws of June 1986; and providing an immediate effective date."

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Department will collect \$320,000 per year in FY90 and FY91.
2. This bill represents a continued savings to the general fund of \$320,000 each year of the biennium.
3. Expenditures for current and proposed law assume a spending pattern based on FY89.
4. Based on the above assumptions, HB391 would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Labor and Industry.
