In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB392. as introduced

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to change the annual registration date for motor homes, travel trailers, and campers from January 1 to July 1; and providing a registration transition provision and payment condition.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Under current law, the fees in lieu of taxes on travel trailers and motor homes expire December 31 and are paid between January 1 and February 15 of the next year. The fees in lieu of taxes on campers are paid under a staggered registration system with payments distributed equally across all months.
- 2. Total FY88 collections from the fee in lieu of tax on travel trailers and motor homes were \$554,053 and \$844,889 respectively. Total collections for travel trailers and motor homes are assumed constant through the next biennium. (Registrar of Motor Vehicles.)
- 3. Total collections from the fee in lieu of tax on campers were \$162,045 in FY88. The amount of total fee collections from campers is assumed constant through the next biennium.
- 4. Mill levies are 6 mills for the University system, 45 mills for the foundation program, and local levies average 197 mills in FY89. (Department of Revenue Assessor's report.)
- 5. This bill is not expected to impact expenditures.
