12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Genetic 13 engineering 14 technology research and development account created. There 15 is created in the designated subfund a restricted account for funds appropriated to Montana state university for 16 17 applied genetic engineering technology research and 18 development. Funds appropriated under [section 2] and money 19 contributed by the Montana agriculture industry must be 20 deposited in the account and are restricted to genetic 21 engineering technology research and development only.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Appropriation. (1) There is 23 appropriated \$160,000 from the renewable resource 24 development bond fund established under 15-35-108(3)(e) to 25 Montana state university for the biennium ending June 30,


