In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB402, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to continue funding for the statewide genetics program; to increase the fee on health insurers; to appropriate money for the program; amending Section 33-2-712, MCA, and Section 7, Chapter 554, laws of 1987; and providing an effective date and a termination date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- Effective July 1, 1989 and terminates June 30, 1991. 1.
- The number of Montana residents insured under the State Employee Group Health Insurance Plan will remain 2. unchanged through the next biennium.
- There are 11,000 health care plan participants under the Board of Regents and the number will remain 3. unchanged through the next biennium.
- Based on 1988 collections, an estimated 715,000 Montana residents were covered as of February 1, 1988. 4.
- Due to increasing health insurance costs, the number of covered residents will drop to 705,000 for FY90 and 5. 700,000 for FY91.
- The Department of Health and Environmental Science grant to Shodair Hospital will equal the revenue received 6. and deposited in the general fund.
