A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A RURAL FIRE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES UNDER CONTRACT TO PRIVATE PARTIES WITHIN CITY LIMITS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UNDER CONTRACT TO PRIVATE PARTIES OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT; AND AMENDING SECTION 7-33-2107, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-33-2107, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-33-2107. Contracts for fire protection services.

- (1) The trustees of such \underline{a} fire district, provided that the owners of 10% of the taxable value of the property in any such the fire district may elect to make such a contract:
- (a) may contract with the council of any city or town or with the trustees of any other fire district established in any unincorporated territory, town, or village which has any boundary line lying within 5 straight-line miles of any boundary line of such the district, whether the city or town or other fire district shall-lie is within the same county or another county, for the extension of fire protection service by the city or town or by such the other fire district to property included within such the district; and

- (b) may agree to pay a reasonable consideration therefor for the service.
- (2) bikewise, the The trustees may contract to permit such the fire district's equipment and facilities to be used by the cities, towns, or other fire districts which have any boundary lines lying within 5 straight-line miles of any boundary line of such the district.
- (3) bikewise, the The trustees may enter into contracts with public or private parties under which such the district fire company may extend fire protection or emergency medical sevice to public or private property lying outside of such the district or any other district or eity limits but within 5 straight-line miles of any boundary line of such the district, whether such the public or private property shall—lie is within the same county or another county. Such The district fire company may use such the fire district's equipment and facilities outside of such the district in the performance of such the contracts.
- (4) All money received from such the contracts shall must be deposited in the county treasurer's office and credited to the fire district fund holding such the contracts.
