4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN
5 ECONOMIC TASK FORCE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; APPROPRIATING
6 MONEY FOR THE TASK FORCE'S USE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
7 DATE AND A TERMINATION DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Economic task force --
11 appropriation. (1) The governor shall establish a
12 nine-member economic task force to:
13 (a) examine the current state of Montana's economy;
14 (b) explore alternatives for revitalizing and
15 diversifying the economy;
16 (c) adopt recommendations for improving the long-term
17 economic health of the state; and
18 (d) report its findings and recommendations to the
19 governor and the 52nd legislature.
20 (2) (a) Subject to the limitation contained in
21 subsection (2)(b), there is appropriated to the governor's
22 office \$300,000 from the general fund for the biennium
23 ending June 30, 1991, for meetings, information gathering,
24 research, consulting services, travel, and other activities
25 necessary for the task force to perform its duties.

1 (b) The money appropriated in subsection (2)(a) may
2 not be expended unless there has been at least a \$1 match
3 from the public for every \$3 to be spent.
4 (3) The appropriation in subsection (2) includes
5 additional spending authority for matching funds donated by
6 the public.
7 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date --
8 termination. [This act] is effective July 1, 1989, and
9 terminates July 1, 1991.

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
