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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Manufacturer's 10

representative's license plates. (1) As used in [this act], "manufacturer's representative" means a resident of Montana who is an employee of a motor vehicle manufacturer licensed under the provisions of 61-4-202 and whose responsibility includes coordinating and promoting sales efforts with the manufacturer's dealers.

- (2) Subject to the provisions of [this act] and notwithstanding the provisions of Title 61, chapter 3, a manufacturer's representative who qualifies as provided in subsection (1) may display manufacturer's license plates on a motor vehicle used solely for business purposes.
- (3) To qualify for the issuance and use manufacturer's license plates by its manufacturer's representatives, the manufacturer licensed under 61-4-202 shall apply on forms and in a manner prescribed by the

department and pay the fees provided for in [section 2].

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Fees. 2 Upon making the application required under (section 1), the manufacturer shall pay to the department a fee of \$250, which entitles the manufacturer to one set of number plates, and an additional fee of \$20 for each additional set of number plates. The manufacturer may receive one set of number 7 plates for each manufacturer's representative.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Assignment of numbers. (1) Upon the licensing of a manufacturer under 61-4-202, the department shall assign to the manufacturer a distinctive serial number and, after payment of fees provided for in furnish every qualified manufacturer's [section 2]. representative of that manufacturer with one set of number plates. Assigned number plates must be similar to number plates furnished to owners of motor vehicles but must bear, in addition to the serial number assigned to manufacturer, the letters "MFG".

(2) The department shall cause to be placed on each set of license plates issued to a manufacturer a serial number assigned to the manufacturer and the actual number of license plates issued to the manufacturer. The department shall provide nonremovable stickers bearing the appropriate county designation. The stickers must be affixed to the license plates in use in accordance with instructions by the

An act allowing a motor vehicle manufacturer's representative to display manufacturer's license plates; establishing qualifications; and providing for fees.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. There are eleven vehicle manufacturer's with representatives in Montana, and four require additional plates.
- 2. Manufacturer's representative is a resident of Montana who is an employee of a motor vehicle manufacturer licensed under the provision of 61-4-202 and whose responsibility includes coordinating and promoting sales efforts with manufacturer's dealer.
- 3. This bill requires Montana license plates for manufacturer's representatives who live in Montana.
- 4. There are 15 manufacturer's representatives in Montana.
