## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing a motor vehicle manufacturer's representative to display manufacturer's license plates; estabiishing qualifications; and providing for fees.

## ASSUMPTIONS :

1. There are eleven vehicle manufacturer's with representatives in Montana, and four require additional plates. 2. Manufacturer's representative is a resident of Montana who is an employee of a motor vehicle manufacturer licensed under the provision of 61-4-202 and whose responsibility includes coordinating and promoting sales efforts with manufacturer's dealer.
2. This bill requires Montana license plates for manufacturer's representatives who live in Montana. 4. There are 15 manufacturer's representatives in Montana.
