date of application, he owns or possesses a machine that was
owned or operated in the state prior to June 30, 1987. A
license-issued-under-this-subsection-expires-for-all
purposes-no-later-than-dune-30,-1989. A used keno machine is
presumed to meet the requirements of 23-5-609, except
subsection (4)(i), (4)(j), and (4)(n), unless the department
has good cause to believe it does not."
