NEW SECTION. Section 1. Incorrect election procedures information. (1) A person may not provide to any elector information about election procedures that is incorrect or misleading. A person, other than an election official, may not mail or otherwise disseminate to electors information prepared in a manner indicating that the information is official information or otherwise sanctioned by election officials.

17 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
