BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Mandatory signs -- pregnancy

under Title 16, chapter 4, other than a person licensed
under 16-4-301 through 16-4-303, shall display in a
prominent place on the premises a sign furnished by the
department of health and environmental sciences that states:
"WARNING! Drinking alcohol during pregnancy may result in
retardation or birth defects in your unborn baby".

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


An act to require certain liquor licenses to display a sign on the premises that warns of the effects of drinking alcohol during pregnancy.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. During SFY88, 1,552 licenses were issued for the sale of alcoholic beverages to those persons not exempted in the proposed legislation. It is assumed the number of licensees will remain fairly constant during the next biennium.
2. An effective size for an educational poster of this type is assumed to be approximately 12" x 15".
3. This legislation assumes that an educational poster provided by DHES will serve as a deterrent to alcohol consumption by pregnant women, and thus assist in preventing alcohol-related disabilities in infants.
