The Department of Institutions shall implement the provisions of this act to establish 40 nursing beds at its Galen facility no earlier than July 1, 1990 contingent upon the following two conditions: (1) that the necessary renovation to the Galen facility, based upon the cost estimates provided by the Department of Administration's Architecture and Engineering division to bring such facility into compliance with applicable federal, state, and federal Veterans Administration licensing and certification requirements, as detailed by the survey reports of the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences and the federal Veteran's Administration, do not exceed \$300,000; and (2) that the department can certify that these 40 nursing beds will be eligible for federal Veteran's Administration per diem payments to state homes for the nursing care of eligible residents. If one of the conditions contained in (1) and (2) of this section cannot be met, then the enabling requirements of this act are void. "



BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Establishment of 40-BED
NURSING HOME annex in Galen, Montana. There is an A 40-BED
NURSING HOME annex of the Montana veterans' home located in
Galen, Montana. The department of institutions shall
operate the facility in the same manner as provided under
this part for operation of the Montana veterans' home in
Columbia Falls.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION. THE
DEPARTMENT OF INSTITUTIONS SHALL IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF
[THIS ACT] TO ESTABLISH 40 NURSING BEDS AT ITS GALEN
FACILITY NO EARLIER THAN JULY 1, 1990, CONTINGENT UPON THE
FOLLOWING TWO CONDITIONS:

(1) THAT THE NECESSARY RENOVATION TO THE GALEN
FACILITY, BASED UPON THE COST ESTIMATES PROVIDED BY THE

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION'S ARCHITECTURE AND ENGINEERING
DIVISION TO BRING SUCH FACILITY INTO COMPLIANCE WITH
APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL VETERANS'
ADMINISTRATION LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS, AS
DETAILED BY THE SURVEY REPORTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES AND THE FEDERAL VETERANS'
ADMINISTRATION, DOES NOT EXCEED \$300,000; AND

(2) THAT THE DEPARTMENT CAN CERTIFY THAT THESE 40
NURSING BEDS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL VETERANS'
ADMINISTRATION PER DIEM PAYMENTS TO STATE HOMES FOR THE
NURSING CARE OF ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS. IF ONE OF THE
CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND THIS SUBSECTION
CANNOT BE MET, THEN THE ENABLING REQUIREMENTS OF [THIS ACT]
ARE VOID.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation. There is
appropriated from the general fund to the department--of
institutions MONTANA STATE HOSPITAL for the biennium ending
June 30, 1991, the sum of {9----} \$425,705 to establish and
